Context

- June 2016 Great Britan voted to leave EU
- Now 2 months left until BREXIT in October 2019
- Hard BREXIT seems to be most likely scenrio
- From Broadcasters perspective it means that Ofcom licenses will not be valied in EU anymore
- About 1200 licences issued by Ofcom for EU coverage
- Need to obtain a licence in one of EU countries



BREXIT to create havoc with TV Broadcasting Licenses

Once Brexit takes effect, the UK broadcasting licence might be at risk for companies broadcasting television channels to other EU member states. After the Brexit activities and when UK has left the EU and as a consequent put UK outside of AVMSD (Audio-Visual Media Services Directive) licensing regime, the OfCom licenses may not be enough anymore to broadcast in rest of Europe. Current developments around Brexit and the EU legislation have created instability, which has already pushed broadcasters into looking for new license countries

There are: 4600+ channels in the main EU markets

1400+ channels are Ofcom (UK) licensed

1000+ of the UK licensed are exported to other EU countries




Other Consequences

- That UK programing will cease to be classified as EU programming for the purpose of the quota rules in the AVMSD, resulting in reduced demand for UK content abroad (as it will not qualify as EU content for local quota purposes).
- The loss of the benefit of the SatCab Directive, with the effect that UK broadcasters
 providing cross-border satellite broadcasting services will have to clear rights in all
 Member States which their signals reach (subject to local law requirements) and not just
 the UK (as is currently the case).
- The loss of the Regulation on the Portability of Online Content (Regulation 2017/1128), meaning that UK subscribers of online content services (such as Netflix) will no longer be able to access these services while temporarily in other EU Member States (for example, on holiday) unless their provider clears giving such access in the relevant member state(s).
- The imposition of other barriers to trade that could affect the UK's media industry, particularly as the EU's digital single market (DSM) strategy develops.


